## *Circle Girls and Boys JV have a strong week*

Circle Christian's Girls finished off a busy week today by winning a tri-match against previously unbeaten Lake Highland Prep and Lake Nona High 159 – 165 – 192. Sierra Brooks (2016) led all scores with an incredible 3 under par 33 at Magnolia Plantation. She was joined by her teammates Dree Fausnaugh (2015), even par 36, and Abbey Carlson's (2016) 39. The wins move the season record to 16-6 with all losses coming to teams that made it to the State Championship last year. Samantha Marks led LHP with a round of 36, while Ashley Holder led Lake Nona with a round of 36 as well. Here is the balance of Circle's scores:

The balance of the scores had Parker Manson 42, Chase Ibbotson 44, Brehnden Daley 53, and Austin Bos 57. Their season record is now 17-7.

On Monday Circle Christian Girls claim 5th place out of 17 teams in the Crutchfield-Hawkins Invitational. Congratulations to the team for shooting its lowest team total in an 18 hole match (323). This was a great experience for our young team to play along side the best teams in the state. The level of play was incredible and the girls will all be able to take something positive away from this experience. Circle was led by Sierra Brooks even par round of 72, followed by Dree Fausnaugh and her score of 74.
