Circle Bowling Team fourth season "road to State Play-off"

On Thursday the Super Six 8th rank Centurions were home against #9 Winter Park Wildcats at Colonial Lanes. The teams would bowl 3 games of 10-Pin with the team having the highest total series winning. In the 1st game both teams came out fired up with Circle's Michael Mathis [2013] firing a career high 237 followed by Michael Campbell [2011] 234 and Sean Vehec [2011] 172 to hold off a strong charge and a 268 game by Winter Park to allow Circle win the game 1012-985. The 1012 game was the second time Circle had broken the 1000 barrier this season. In the 2nd game Circle's Christopher Mathis [2011] shot a season high 258 game which outpaced Winter Park 244 game and Michael Mathis added the second punch with a 211 game as Circle won 935-874. In the 3rd game Circle Christopher Mathis shot 215 and Jake Beavers [2012] finished strong with a 173 game to help Circle stay close to Winter Park's 240 game as Winter Park won the game 922-895.

Circle won the match with a 2842-2781 total. Christopher Mathis led Circle with a season high 664 series [221.3 avg.]. Circles varsity season record is 13-1.

The 1st game Adam Weber [2010] and Kami Winans [2012] had a strike as Circle lost 182-122. In the 2nd game AJ Vehec [2015], Kenzie Winans [2011] and Kami Winans had a strike as Circle won 124-109. In the 3rd game Adam Weber and Kenzie Winans had a spare each as Circle lost 132-107. In the 4th game Kami Winans had 2 strikes, Adam Weber and Kenzie Winans had one strike and Nat Lisko [2015] added a spare as Circle won 158-117. The 5th game Circle was down by 38 pins and got a strike from Adam Weber, Kenzie Winans and Kami Winans and a spare from AJ Vehec as Circle won 158-107.

Circle won the match with a 669-657 total. Kenzie Winans led Circle with 80% Marks. Circles JV season record is 5-3.
