Circle Bowling Team fourth season "road to State Play-off"

On Monday Circle was home against Foundation Academy. The teams bowled 2 games of 10-pin and then 3 games of Baker. In game one of 10-pins Circle's Michael Campbell [2011] opened up with a 224 and received help from Michael Mathis [2013] 211 as Circle won 887-764. In game two Circle's Christopher Mathis [2011] shot the biggest game of the day 232 and Michael Campbell followed up with a 227 as Circle pulled away and won 923-788. In games 3 through 5 the teams moved to Baker Format. Game three Circle's Christopher Mathis had 2 strikes and Jake Beavers [2012] had a strike and spare as Circle won the closest game 155-125. Game 4 Circle's Michael Campbell had 2 strikes in the 10th and senior JV player moved up to varsity team in his last match of his career, because of age, had 2 spares as Circle won going away 182-118. The fifth game Circle's Michael Mathis had a strike and spare, Jake Beavers had 2 spares and Michael Campbell had a strike and 2 spares as Circle finished out the clean sweep winning 168-127.

Circle won the match 5-0. Michael Campbell led Circle with a 451 series [225.5 avg.] and 87% marks in Baker. Circles season record is 14-1.
