Current Circle students

Before a current student can register for any class or program, the family must have filed a *Re-enrollment Form* with the appropriate fees for the 2009-10 school year and be current on all reports and fees for the 2008-09 school year. *Re-enrollment Forms* must be obtained from the Circle office.

Before a new student will be considered for registration in any class or program, the family must complete the application process and the student must be accepted for enrollment in the school.

Terms and Conditions

The cost of the program is based on the sum of two fees, a registration fee and a participation fee.

- *Registration Fee* — \$150.00 - This non-refundable fee must be submitted at the time of registration for each student in the program
- *Participation Fee* — \$800.00 - This fee must be paid, either in full by August 1, 2009, or in ten monthly payments of \$80.00 from August 1-May 1.

Because of the progressive curriculum and staffing obligations, it is important to understand that the class must be taken as a complete unit. Enrollment is for the length of the program (two semesters). Classes meet from the week of August 17 – November 23, 2009 for the first semester and January 11 – March 29, 2010 for the second semester. If, for any reason, the student does not attend a class session, payment is still due. The program is based on a six-month schedule (25 weeks) and a ten-month financial commitment (August 1-May 1).
