A. Circle Christian School and Parent-Directed Education

Circle Christian School is a private Christian organization which exists for the purpose of glorifying the Lord Jesus Christ by assisting Christian families in providing Godly education and academic excellence. Circle's goal is to blend the best elements of the conventional school model with the one-on-one tutorial instruction of homeschooling. Circle offers families the accountability and structure of a private school while insuring parents the influence and control of a homeschooling format.

The school adheres to the conviction that God has ordained that parents are primarily responsible for the education of their children. The school provides assistance and support to Christian parents who subscribe to this belief. The two-fold goal of education is first to create within the student the desire to learn and, secondly, to give the child the ability to relate well to the world around him. The goal of Christian education is to accomplish this while acknowledging and applying the absolute standard of God's Word, the Bible. Because education is more than the mere gaining of academic knowledge, the school is committed to encouraging an environment in which families can more effectively cultivate the qualities of Character, Integrity, Responsibility, Creativity, Leadership, and Excellence in every facet of life. (Students should also read the Statement of Faith provided in the application packet for parents.)

B. Student Appearance and Behavior

In order to provide the assurance of a wholesome Christian atmosphere and to prevent any negative reflection on the school itself, Circle reserves the right to review any pertinent information, records, or circumstance of any applicant or enrolled individual or family. Circle reserves the right to ask for letters of referral or may contact former schools, etc. to request references regarding any individual or family. Any information gathered will be kept confidential. The Board of Directors reserves the right to take whatever steps it deems necessary toward any individual or family in order to insure that Circle's reputation and purpose are not hindered. Such action includes, but is not limited to, the denial of enrollment or removal from enrollment of any student or family. In the event of action by the Board of Directors, all student records will remain confidential and will be kept by Circle.

The school has a *Dress and Conduct Code*. Students are required to read the attached copy. Students are expected to exhibit an appearance and behavior that will be appropriate and in keeping with a Christian testimony in accordance with traditional Biblical standards. The Administration reserves the right to dismiss any student who fails to comply with these standards from an activity or group class. Continued behavior in opposition to these standards may result in exclusion from school events.

In Reference to the *Curriculum Declaration for 2010-11*

1. By using the enclosed Documents III.A and III.B, complete the course declaration plan by providing the requested information. If all requested information is not known or available, the application may still be submitted. If the course plan is incomplete, it needs to be updated by Wednesday, July 7, 2010.

If another form is needed in order to complete or update the course plan, Section III of the high school student application may be printed from the Circle web site before June 17, 2010. It will not be available online after that date.

2. The following information provides an explanation of “Source of Instruction” columns.
 - a. Parent Instruction – The parent will be the primary source of instruction for the subject.
 - b. CCS Group Class – The student will take the subject in a CCS group class at any of the locations available.

Selecting this option does not automatically enroll the student in a course. Registration for the class is on a first-come, first-serve basis. The process for registration is provided on the Circle Web site at www.circlechristianschool.org.

- c. Non CCS Group Class – This is an individual subject that is provided through another source in the community and not affiliated with Circle.
 - d. Non CCS Program – This is a block format for classes or a full-day program that is not affiliated with Circle.
 - e. Video/Computer – This source delivers instruction from a video/dvd curriculum and/or an online/distance learning method and is not affiliated with Circle.
 - f. Private Tutor – This is a person or tutorial service retained by a family to provide instruction for the student.
 - g. Other – This is a source that does not meet the criteria for any of the categories listed.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

(For students entering their first year of high school in 2007-08 school year in Compliance with Dept. of Education (DOE) Florida Statute 1003.43)

Successful completion of a minimum of 24 academic credits in Grades 9 - 12 shall be required for graduation.

The 24 credits shall be distributed as indicated.

- * Four credits in **English**, with major concentration in composition, reading for information, and literature
- * Four credits in **Mathematics**, one of these credits must be Algebra I or equivalent, or a higher-level course
- * Three credits in **Science**, two of which must have a laboratory component
- * Three credits in **Social Studies**
 - One credit in American History
 - One credit in World History, including a comparative study of history, doctrines, and objectives of all major political systems
 - One-half credit in American Government, including the study of Florida Government and municipal and county governments
 - One-half credit in Economics, including a comparative study of the history, doctrines, and objectives of all major economic systems
- * One credit in **Fine Arts** which can include courses in art, dance, drama, music, speech, debate
- * One credit in **Physical Education** to include integration of health [Personal Fitness course which includes integration of health and one other physical education course]
(Participation only on varsity school teams and cheerleading are not acceptable for credit. Students must also take and pass a comprehensive Personal Fitness exam to be administered by the CCS Director of Guidance in order for a credit to be awarded for team participation.)
- * Eight **Elective** credits (This includes a minimum of one-half credit in Bible each year for the student who is enrolled in CCS. Also, since foreign language is not required for high school graduation but is required for college admission, foreign language is considered included in the elective courses. Once a subject area requirement listed above has been met, courses in the same subject area will be considered an elective.)

CREDIT REQUIREMENTS FOR COLLEGE-READY PLAN

The Florida Board of Regents requires completion of the following eighteen credits for College Preparatory Courses. Calculation of a student's Grade Point Average (GPA) will be based ONLY on these college preparatory courses.

- * English [4 credits] Three courses must include substantial writing requirements.
- * Math [4 credits] The courses must be at the Algebra I and above level.
- * Natural Science [3 credits] Two courses must include substantial laboratory requirements.
- * Social Science / Studies [3 credits] Courses must include World History, American History, American Government, and Economics. Academic elective credits include history, civics, political science, economics, sociology, psychology, and geography.
- * Foreign Language [2 credits] Both credits must be in the same language. For the purpose of admission requirements to the State University System, American Sign Language will be accepted in place of a foreign language but will not count as credit for a university graduation requirement in foreign language.
- * Additional Academic Electives [2 credits] These credits are electives from the above five subject areas.

The *Florida Virtual School (FLVS)* provides free online classes and instruction to all public, private, and homeschool students in Florida. According to its logo statement "online learning provides students and families the flexibility to learn any time, any place, any path, any pace." For more information, visit the website at www.flvs.net. There is a specific registration process that MUST include online approval from Circle. Note: Students enrolled in Circle Christian School are designated as private school students.

The **Dual Enrollment Program** offered through the Community Colleges is an option for eligible 11th – 12th grade students. Eligibility includes a combined minimum score of 970 on the SAT Reasoning Test or a composite score of 20 on the ACT and a minimum grade point average of 3.0 (B). Note: Final decision for dual enrollment is determined by Circle's Director of Guidance.
